RESOLUTION providing for and requiring the submission of the proposition of expanding the purpose of The Rock Island County Public Building Commission, Rock Island County, Illinois, at the consolidated election to be held on the 9th day of April, 2013.

WHEREAS, The County of Rock Island, Illinois (the "County"), is a duly organized and existing county created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Counties Code of the State of Illinois, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 20/4a of the Public Building Commission Act of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Act") provides that the purpose of a public building commission, created by the county board of any county for a limited and specific purpose, may be expanded if the question of expanding such purpose is certified by the County Board to the proper election authority and submitted to the voters of the County at a regular election held and conducted in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code") and approved by a majority of the electors voting on said proposition in said county; and

WHEREAS, The Rock Island County Public Building Commission, Rock Island County, Illinois (the "Commission"), a municipal corporation heretofore duly organized under the provisions of the Act, was created and incorporated by the County Board of the County (the "County Board") for the limited purpose of providing a good and sufficient jail for use in the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Board does hereby find and determine that the purpose of the Commission be expanded to include all the powers and authority prescribed by the Act (the "Proposition"); and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the County that the Proposition be submitted to the voters of the County at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election law:

Now, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Resolved by the County Board of the County of Rock Island, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The County Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Submission to Voters. The Proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the County in accordance with the general election law at the consolidated election to be held on Tuesday, the 9th day of April, 2013, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M. on said day (the "Election").

Section 3. Voting Precincts and Polling Places. The Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board, for voters of the County at the Election.

Section 4. Election Notice. The County Clerk shall give notice of the Election in accordance with the general election law by (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the County, and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the County Clerk.

Section 5. Newspaper of General Circulation. It is hereby found and determined that the Rock Island Argus/Dispatch is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the County as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code.

Section 6. Form of Notice. The Notice shall appear over the name or title of the County Clerk and shall be substantially in the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the consolidated election to be held on Tuesday, the 9th day of April, 2013, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of The County of Rock Island, Illinois:

Shall the County Board of The County of Rock Island be authorized to expand the purpose of The Rock Island Public Building Commission, Rock Island County, Illinois to include all the powers and authority prescribed by the Public Building Commission Act?

The polls at the election will be open at 6:00 o'clock A.M. and will continue to be open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of that day.
